

COURT SEEKS INQUIRY REPORT INTO VIJAYENDRA'S TEMPLE VISIT

The CM's son admitted to his visit to Srikanteshwara temple in reply to notice issued by Mysuru DC

OBSERVING that allowing political people to enter temples to offer puja when a government order does not permit it, will send wrong signals, the Karnataka High Court on Thursday directed the state government to submit the preliminary inquiry report by the Mysuru Deputy Commissioner into BJP state vice-president BY Vijayendra and his wife's visit to Srikanteshwara temple in Nanjangud on May 18, 2021.

Passing the order, a division bench of Chief Justice Abhay Shreenivas Oka and Justice Suraj Govindaraj said it will take the issue to its logical conclusion, after the DC's report is submitted to court. Vijayendra has admitted to his temple visit, in a reply to a notice on May 29, issued by the Mysuru DC.



COURT STAYS MYSURU MAYORAL ELECTION

Bengaluru: The Karnataka High Court on Thursday stayed the election for the Mayor of Mysuru City Corporation that was scheduled to be held on June 11. However, the court said that the authorities can take the decision to hold the election after assessing the Covid situation when the lockdown is lifted. Passing the interim order after hearing a petition filed by Congress corporator Pradeep, Justice Sachin Shankar Magadam issued notice to the Additional Chief Secretary of the Urban Development Department and Commissioner of Mysore City Corporation. The petitioner contended that the guidelines issued under the Disaster Management Act prohibits gathering of people. If elections are held, the corporators and their followers will gather which may lead to spread of Covid-19, he said.

Advocate General (AG) Prabhuling K Navadagi submitted that Vijayendra went to Nanjangud to launch an ambulance service at 8.30 am, and entered the temple to offer puja as it was open. But an impression was created that he went to go to the temple with family, he argued.

Thereafter, the court asked the

AG to say whether a citizen can enter a temple, to which he got a negative reply. The court observed that the law applicable to political persons is applicable to all. It sends wrong signals when political persons are allowed to enter temples when there is prohibition, but citizens are not. This truth was found out as he

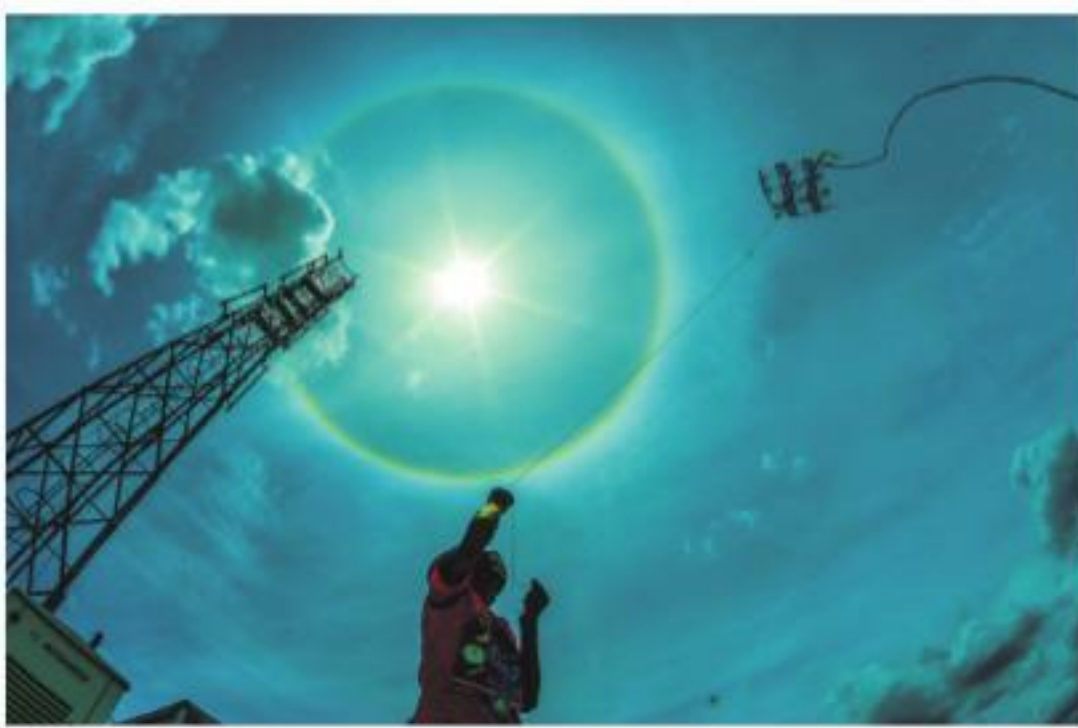
(Vijayendra) admitted he had entered the temple. He need not enter the temple if he went for Covid-related work.

Meanwhile, the court directed counsel to file an affidavit on the photograph of Vijayendra and his wife visiting the temple, attached to the petition. The next hearing is on June 18.

Gold bangles of Covid victim turn out fake, cops grill nurses

Bengaluru: The Yelahanka police on Thursday questioned three women nursing staffers of private hospital after two gold bangles, worth Rs 1.5 lakh, of a 61-year-old Covid-19 victim were allegedly replaced with duplicates. An officer said that Krishnappa B, husband of Bhagyamma, filed a complaint against the hospital staff on June 5, alleging that his wife had worn two gold bangles when she was hospitalised. She died on May 25 and the family received the body and the ornaments. Later, the family noticed that the gold bangles were fake and approached the police. ENS

Six nabbed with drugs worth Rs 30 lakh

Continuing investigation into the Kannamangala drug peddling case, the Central Crime Branch (CCB) police have arrested five more men and seized ecstasy pills and LSD strips worth Rs 30 lakh. The accused are Bayan Ansari (26), Arnold Pascal D'Souza (27), Anirudh Venkatchalam (23), Kanishq Reddy (23), and Santosh K (28). With this, the total number of arrests in the case has gone up to 11, with six men, including a Nigerian national, nabbed during a raid on a house at Kannamangala on April 29. "We have recovered 119 ecstasy pills and 150 LSD blots worth Rs 30 lakh," the police said. ENS

Woman, paramour held for torturing minor girls

THE Rajarajeshwari Nagar police on Thursday arrested a 26-year-old woman and her paramour for brutally torturing her two minor daughters after they revealed about the affair to their father. The accused Jayamma (24), a hospital housekeeping staffer, and Hemanth (27), a daily wage labourer, both from Hassan, were staying in in RR Nagar.

A senior police officer said that the duo was arrested based on a complaint by the neighbours, and have been booked under the Juvenile Justice Act.

On Wednesday evening, the neighbours heard the children screaming and alerted the police. The kids were rescued and rushed to a private hospital. Later, the police arrested the accused and are waiting for the medical reports to take further action, an officer said.

Cong leader gives away veggies, hens

THROWING Covid norms out of the window, people of Shivanagar ward in Rajajinagar flocked to collect groceries and vegetables being distributed by a local Congress leader on Thursday. There was also a live hen for each beneficiary. Former BBMP councillor Vijaykumar and his wife Manjula Vijaykumar, along with local Congress workers, distributed the goods to the needy.

Vijaykumar said that they were working under KPCC president DK Shivakumar's guidance, and had been providing free breakfast and lunch to the poor for one-and-half months.

Vijaykumar said they distributed 15-18 kg of vegetables and the hen was initially not part of the package. But a youth who had a poultry farm approached him for financial help. "Instead of giving him money, we procured 1.2 tonnes of fowl — around 600 birds — and distributed them," he stated.

One local BJP worker said that the crowd was because of the bird. To which Vijaykumar said, "People were at least wearing masks. We did not announce that hens were being given, or more people would have come."
